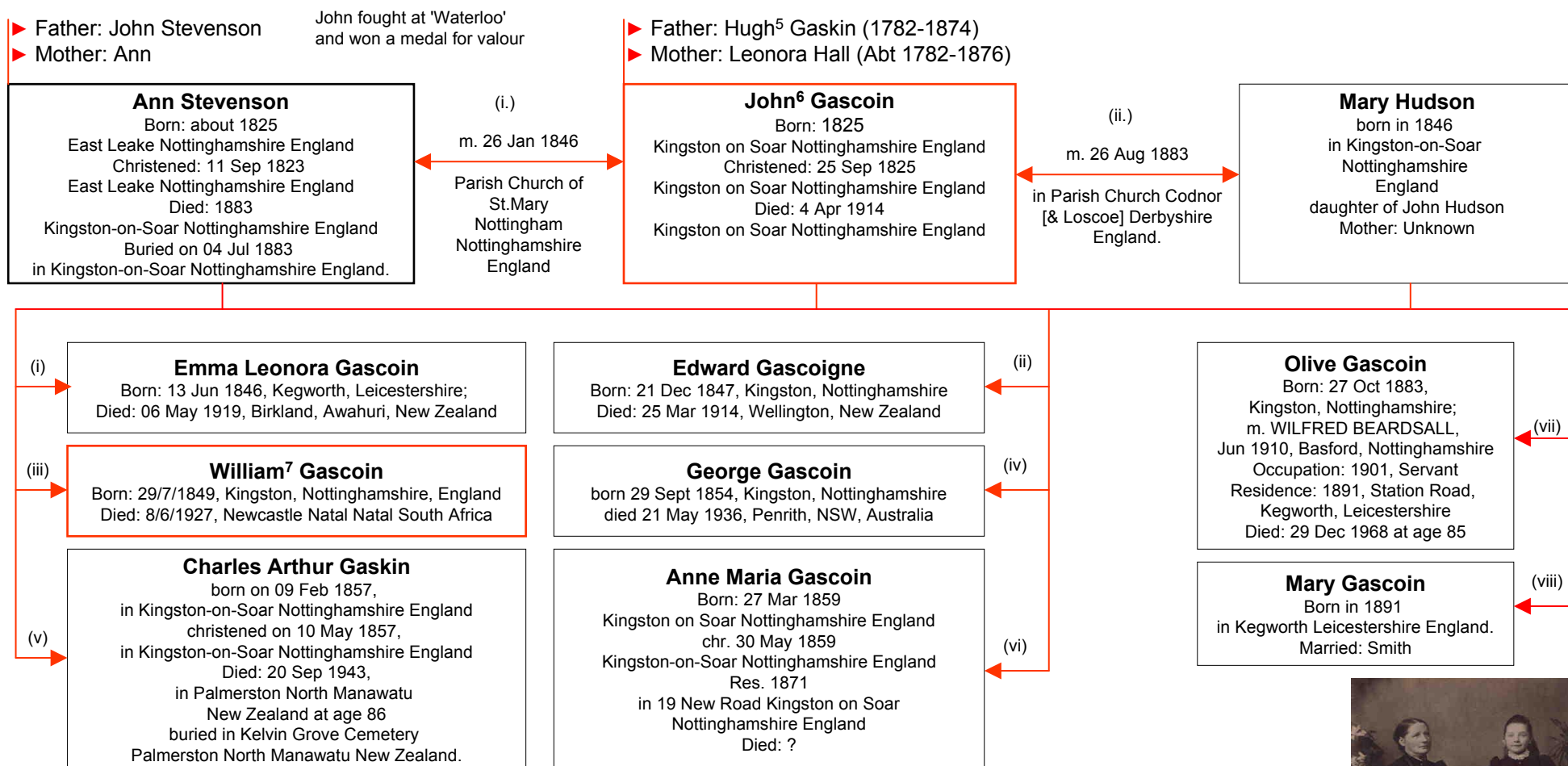


Descendants of John⁶ Gascoin & Ann & Mary (1825-1914) (6th Generation)



General Notes for John⁶ Gascoin:

The GASCOIGNE family were proud that they came from Gascony, France, at the time of the Norman Conquest (1066).

John in trouble with the Law:

Nottingham Shire Hall - Quarter Sessions 23 June 1854 "JOHN GASCOIGNE and THOMAS DEXTER (of Kingston on Soar) were charged with committing a breach of the peace at Ratcliffe-on-Soar on the 13th instant at 2 o'clock in the morning. It was the night after the Wakes. On promising not to repeat the offence, the prisoners were discharged on paying the expenses, 7s 6d each." Note; John Gascoigne was a 28 year old labourer (son of Hugh and Leonora Gaskin) married with children. Thomas Dexter was a 25 year old labourer with children. Both lived in the "new" cottages round the Green, Kingston Village. (not clear where the note originated.)
